



# Getting To and From the National Ageing Research Institute (NARI)

## How do I get there?

NARI is easily accessible by both car and public transport. It is located on the Royal Park Campus of the Royal Melbourne Hospital (formerly called Melbourne Extended Care and Rehabilitation Service). (See map below). The buildings are accessed via Gate 4, 34-54 Poplar Road Parkville. Please note that this is **not** the main campus of the Royal Melbourne Hospital.

## By Car

Enter the public car park via Gate 1 on the northern side of Poplar Rd. A flat rate parking fee of \$9\* applies using coins or credit card. Change is available at campus reception near the car park.

All day metered parking is available in Park St close to Gate 5 and some free 2 hour street parking is also available in surrounding areas.

Limited disabled persons' parking is available near Gardenview House and the Robert Campbell Wing. Enter via Gate 4 on Poplar Rd.

## By Public Transport

- **Tram:**

From William Street in the city, the 58 tram (West Coburg) runs along Peel Street and Flemington Road and through Royal Park. Get off at stop number 26 near the Royal Park train station, and walk along Poplar Rd, away from the Zoo and the train station – NARI is on the northern side, Gate 4, Royal Park Hospital. From the tram stop it is a 10 minute walk to NARI.

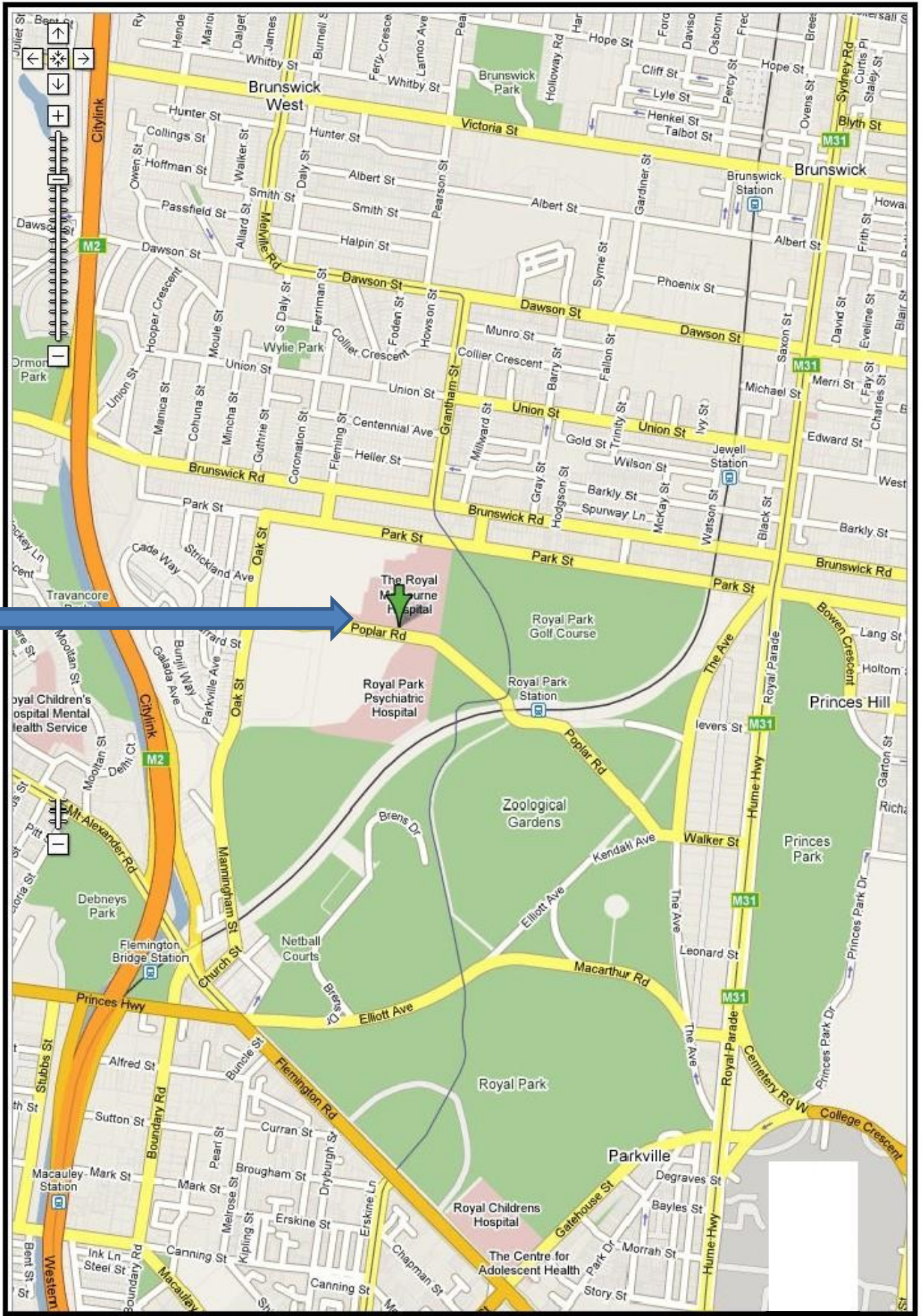
- **Train:**

Catch the Upfield train and get off at Royal Park Station. Head west and walk along Poplar Rd – NARI is on the right hand side, Gate 4, Royal Park Hospital. From the train station it is a 10 minute walk to NARI.

- **Bus:**

**Route 505** - Moonee Ponds Junction – Melbourne University (Royal Parade near Genetics Lane) via Parkville Gardens Estate. There are bus stops immediately outside Gate 4 whether arriving from Moonee Ponds or University of Melbourne.

**Route 504:** Moonee Ponds Junction - Clifton Hill Station, Hoddle Street. Get off the bus at the stop near Grantham Street, Brunswick, follow tram track through to Park Street and enter the RMH Parkville campus via Gate 5. You can then use the “Campus Map” to find your way to NARI and buildings, approximately a 10 minute walk.
